Surrounded by the majestic Northern Alps in northern Nagano Prefecture, Hakuba Valley spans Omachi City, Hakuba Village, and Otari Village. Once a stage for the 1998 Nagano Winter Olympics, it is now Japan's largest mountain resort, attracting winter sports fans from around the world. Enjoy abundant, high-quality powder snow and a wide variety of terrain across 10 unique ski resorts—from gentle beginner slopes to long cruising runs up to 8,000 meters.

Hakuba Valley Safety Tips

Guidelines for enjoying Hakuba Valley ski resorts and backcountry safely

SKI RESORT

- Pay attention to "boundary" and "closed area" signs.
- Control your speed while skiing or snowboarding.
- Pay attention to your surroundings and check the situation.
- Leashes are mandatory for snowboards.
- Wearing a helmet is highly recommended.
- Do not enter deep powder areas alone.
- Ski resorts are off-limits outside operating hours.
- Violating ski resort rules will result in the suspension of your lift ticket and you will be asked to leave the resort.
- Contact ski resort staff immediately in case of emergency.

BACKCOUNTRY

- Use the designated gates when leaving a controlled ski area.
- Backcountry areas are not maintained and pose various dangers.
- There are some closed areas adjacent to ski resorts.
- Preparation and equipment are essential.
- Check Mountain Information and Avalanche Bulletin.
- Go backcountry with experienced skiers or snowboarders in a group.
- Inexperienced backcountry skiers or snowboarders are recommended to be accompanied by a professional local guide.
- Search and rescue may take time and be costly.
- Call the police (110) or the fire department (119) immediately in case of an emergency.

We recommend insurance covering ski resort accidents and backcountry rescue. Choose insurance that includes personal liability coverage for ski resorts and rescue coverage for backcountry activities.
